

TOWN OF OXFORD
ORDINANCE NO. 28
FIRE SIGN FEE

This ordinance is adopted under the Town of Oxford's authority under Chapter 60 of the Wisconsin State Statutes.

The Town of Oxford requires fire signs for all properties in the Town with improvements on them.

In accordance with Wisconsin State Statute 60.55(2)(b), the Town of Oxford does hereby set forth and adopt for the general law of the Town of Oxford the following:

The fee for fire signs, new or replacement, shall be \$75.00. This fee shall cover the actual cost of the sign, installation and administrative costs involved with issuing a fire sign.

The Town Board of the Town of Oxford does hereby elect and direct that notice of the enactment of this ordinance shall be given by the posting of true, correct and complete copies at the following locations: U.S. Post Office, Royal Bank, Grand Marsh State Bank and Oxford Town Hall.

This ordinance shall become effective as of January 1, 2005.
