

ORDINANCE 29
AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN
OF THE TOWN OF OXFORD, WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of Oxford, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to sections 60.22(3) and 62.23(2) and (3) of Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Oxford is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 2. The Town Board of the Town of Oxford has adopted and followed written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.1001(4)(a) of Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 3. The Plan Commission of the Town of Oxford, by a majority vote of the entire Commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the Town Board the adoption of the document entitled Town of Oxford Comprehensive Plan, containing all of the elements specified in section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 4. The Town of Oxford has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of Wisconsin Statutes, and provided numerous other opportunities for public involvement per its adopted public participation strategy and procedures.

SECTION 5. The Town Board of the Town of Oxford, Wisconsin, does, by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled, Town of Oxford Comprehensive Plan, pursuant to section 66.1001(4)(c) of Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Town Board and posting in at least 3 public places as required by law.
