

TOWN OF OXFORD
ORDINANCE NUMBER 40
ADOPT THE UPDATED TOWN OF OXFORD COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

The Board of the Town of Oxford, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Town of Oxford is authorized to prepare and adopt an update to the Town of Oxford Comprehensive Plan as defined in Sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. The Board of the Town of Oxford has adopted and followed written procedures designed to foster public participation during the comprehensive plan update process as required by Section 66.1001(4)(a) of Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 3. The Town Plan Commission has adopted a resolution recommending the Town Board adopt the updated Comprehensive Plan, containing all of the elements specified in Section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 4. The Town Board has held at least one public hearing on this ordinance and associated Comprehensive Plan, in compliance with the requirements Section 66.1001(4)(d) of Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 5. The Town Board of the Town of Oxford, Wisconsin, does, by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the updated Town of Oxford Comprehensive Plan, pursuant to Section 66.1001(4)(c) of Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members elect of the Town Board and posting as required by law.


