

TOWN OF OXFORD
REGULAR MEETING
APRIL 12, 2017

The regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Oxford was held at the Town Hall on Wednesday, April 12, 2017 at 6:00 PM. Present were Keith Wohlfert, Greg Goodhue, Steve Klump, Peggy Russell, Mary Walters and several visitors.

A motion by Klump/Goodhue to approve the minutes from the March 8, 2017 Regular Meeting. Motion carried.

A motion by Goodhue/Klump to approve the agenda for April 12, 2017. Motion carried.

Natalie Bussan, attorney for Mary Bonte-Spath was present regarding the annexation of property owned by Jeraldine Spath from the Town of Oxford into the Village of Oxford. The request was made because of a failing septic system on Jeraldine Spath's property and she wishes to become connected to the Village of Oxford sanitary system. Ms. Bussan indicated that the Village of Oxford has approved the request upon approval of the Town. The board has indicated it would like to work with the Village to be able for Mrs. Spath to connect with the Village's sanitary system, but retain the property in the Town. Ms. Bussan indicated she would talk with her client and let the Village and the Town know her client's decision. There was no board action on this item at this time.
