

TOWN OF OXFORD
REGULAR MEETING
JULY 13, 2017

The regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Oxford was held at the Town Hall on Thursday, July 13, 2017 at 5:35 PM. Present were Keith Wohlfert, Greg Goodhue, Steve Klump, Peggy Russell, Mary Walters and several visitors.

A motion by Goodhue/Klump to approve the minutes from the June 8, 2017 Regular Meeting. Motion carried.

A motion by Goodhue/Klump to approve the agenda for July 13, 2017, with item #6 being moved to follow item #9. Motion carried.

A motion by Klump/Goodhue to approve a rezone request from Danny Steffens, on recommendation from the Town of Oxford Plan Commission, to recommend to the Marquette County Planning and Zoning Committee to rezone from AG(O) to Residential/Recreational minimum acreage of 100 feet wide for a total amount of no less than 30,000 square feet, with a deed restriction that this parcel is not buildable. Motion carried.

Tom Onofrey of the Marquette County Planning & Zoning Department was present to explain how rezones work and that the plan commission should have 5 members. We currently have 4. He will send the resolution paperwork for consideration at the August meeting.

Ken Stein was present along with Attorney Rick Schmidt to address the Union Pacific Railroad Bridge over N. 2nd Court. He and the other residents are concerned about an emergency access/outlet if the bridge were to fail. Discussion. No action.

Attorney John Orton introduced himself to the board and provided information about himself and his firm. Town Attorney Steve Chiquoine is retiring at the end of summer and the board is looking for another attorney. No action.

A motion by Goodhue/Klump to adopt Ordinance #41-Designating Class B Highways. Motion carried. (Note: The Town Clerk posted the signed ordinance on the notice board of the Town Hall and on the Town's website on July 14, 2017)

A motion by Klump/Goodhue to have the clerk provide road maintenance dollar amounts to the Marquette County Highway Department that was requested by them for the past 3 years, that the town spent with other contractors. Motion carried.

Klump left the meeting at 6:50 pm.

A motion by Goodhue/Wohlfert to approve the Treasurer's Report. Motion carried.

A motion by Wohlfert/Goodhue to approve an operator's license for Lisa Bignell. Motion carried.

A motion by Goodhue/Wohlfert to approve a cigarette license for Smokes 4 U, with Susan Hollenbeck as new owner/agent. Motion carried.

A motion by Wohlfert/Goodhue to approve the Clerk's Report. Motion carried.

A motion by Wohlfert/Goodhue to adjourn. Motion carried.
